How To Get There

April Monthly Party:

Lucie Stern Recreation Center, 1350 Middlefield Road, Palo Alto

FROM 280: Take Page Mill Road east and turn left on Middlefield. The hall will be on your right.

FROM 101: Take Embarcadero west.. Turn right on Middlefield. The hall will be on your right.

Park on the street or in the free parking lot next to the building.

May Monthly Party:

Temple United Methodist Church, 65 Beverly Street, near Junipero Serra and 19th Avenue, San Francisco

FROM THE EAST: In San Francisco, take 101 north or south, to 280 split; merge onto 280 South toward DALY CITY. Take the exit toward CA-82 / MISSION ST / CA-1 N / DALY CITY; merge onto SAN JOSE AVE; turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto SAGAMORE ST; then turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto BROTHERHOOD WAY. Take the JUNIPERO SERRA BLVD / CA-1 N ramp, merge onto JUNIPERO SERRA BLVD and stay in the rightmost lane. At gas station (first light) bear sharp diagonal right onto 19th Avenue south. Then immediately turn left onto BEVERLY. Park in the lot or on the street. Enter church hall from Beverly.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take 280 North, exit onto 19th Ave. (CA-1) North and stay in the rightmost lane. At gas station (first light) bear sharp diagonal right onto 19th Ave. Then immediately turn left onto BEVERLY. Park in the lot or on the street. Enter church hall from Beverly.

FROM THE NORTH: Take 19th Ave. (Rte. 1) South to intersection with JUNIPERO SERRA BLVD, after the slight curve to the east. Stay in the middle or left lanes. At the light go straight onto 19th Ave. south. Then immediately turn left onto BEVERLY. Park in the lot or on the street. Enter church hall from Beverly.

June Monthly Party:

Live Oak Grange, 1900 17th Avenue, Santa Cruz

FROM 17 SOUTH: Take Route 1 south towards Watsonville/Monterey and exit at Soquel Ave (Exit 439). Turn left onto Soquel Ave and then 2nd right onto 17th Ave. The Grange will be on your left.
