APPLICATION INFORMATION

- ◆ Your application form, with a **\$75 deposit**, must be **postmarked or submitted and paid for on-line using PayPal (with a small non-refundable shipping/handling fee) at Asilomar.rscds-sf.org by Friday, April 27th!** If the weekend is oversubscribed, all applications received by the due date will be subject to a lottery.
- ◆ You may pay the full registration fee with your application. Please be advised that paying the full amount does not guarantee your acceptance if the Weekend is oversubscribed and subject to a lottery. Should that be the case, and you are not accepted, the full fee will be refunded - BUT any PayPal fees incurred are non-refundable.
- ◆ You will receive your admission status (accepted or waitlisted) in **mid-May**. Once you are accepted, your deposit is non-refundable.
- ◆ In **mid-July** registration packets will be sent requesting applicant details: dance experience, class choices, housing preferences, roommates, volunteering, and work exchange.
- ◆ Full payment, along with the registration, is due by **Friday, August 24th**.
- ◆ Persons 17 and under must be accompanied by, and room with, a parent or authorized adult.
- ◆ Attendees are responsible for any children accompanying them to this event, since neither the Asilomar Conference Center nor the San Francisco Branch provide supervision or programs for children.
- ◆ Non-dancers are invited to watch the dance activities or make other arrangements to enjoy their weekend.
- ◆ All the information about the weekend is on the first two pages. Keep it for your records.
- ◆ Recordings or photographs may be made of sessions during the weekend for archival or non-commercial purposes, including publicity. By submitting your application, you consent to being in such recordings/photographs.
